D. Additional requirements

E MALAGA01

Home institution has to provide the International Relations and Cooperation Office with the "Nomination of incoming Erasmus students selected" to study at the University of Málaga. Nomination is essential for acceptance.

UMA can only accept the number of students stipulated in the actual inter-institutional agreement.

UMA cannot accept Erasmus students from areas of study different from those stipulated in the actual inter-institutional agreement.

Some modules have limited places (especially in the Faculty of Languages and Humanities). Different options for modules/subjects should be considered.

No hard copies are required for application forms or learning agreements (online procedure for both documents).

The University of Málaga has the infrastructure to welcome students and staff with disabilities. Acceptance and further arrangements need to be agreed in advance.

PL BIALYSTOK04

- Local mentors will help incoming students with practical issues like opening a bank account, registration procedures etc.
- Applicants with specials need will be contacted before the final approval of the acceptance. Final decision depends on extra services/facilities available. Please contact International Cooperation Office in order to get more information.

2. E MALAGA01

The receiving institution will send its decision within a number of weeks depending on the date of the reception of the official nomination of students selected. Nevertheless it will always be by the 30th June/November.

PL BIALYST04

The receiving institution will send its decision within six weeks.

3. E MALAGA01

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the International Relations and Cooperation Office no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at UMA. (Exception: in some cases 1st semester student's transcripts will be issued within 7 weeks).

PL BIALYST04

A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **four weeks** after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]

4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

This agreement will take effect in the xxxx academic year being valid until the end of the two year contract period starting 2020 (thus 2022).

Either institution is free to terminate the present agreement. In order to do so, the institution wishing to terminate the agreement must:

- I. Notify the other institution in writing of its intention, by giving at least a 12 months' notice, stating the date on which it intends to make the termination effective. That is to say, a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. In consequence, any students who have started their exchange experience at either university at the date of termination may complete their stay.
- II. Termination of the agreement will not be penalised.

Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

F. Information

1. Grading systems of the institutions

The grading system used by Spanish universities is based on specific attainment levels, rather than on a numerical scale or statistical basis. It should be noted that the mark, 'Matrícula de Honor', which is the highest grade, is rarely given.
