 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than five weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
 - 4. Termination of the agreement

The agreement will become operative on the date of signature of both universities and shall remain in force for a period of 7 years. In case of the termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be sent to the partner university. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
